

Sign Up to Help with TAG DAY

What is Tag Day?

Tag Day is THE major music fund raiser for the year. On Tag Day, all music and color guard members canvass as many homes as possible within the Chantilly school district, in an effort to raise tax-deductible donations for support of the program.

When is it held?

2017 Tag Day will be held on Saturday, September 9th. It lasts from about 7AM until 2 PM. *The rain date is the Saturday, September 16th.*

Who participates?

Participation in Tag Day includes ALL members of the music program. It also takes about 100 parent volunteers (see list of opportunities below), so please consider helping. No experience necessary!

Where is it held?

The event will begin and end at Chantilly High School. Activities during the day occur within the Chantilly School District.

How is it organized?

The Chantilly School District is divided into sectors. Working students - in teams of at least two and under the constant supervision of a parent/driver - solicit donations house by house on streets assigned to them by the Tag Day Coordinators.

A sample schedule with a little more detail...

7:45 AM Students arrive at the school and enjoy breakfast.

8:00 AM Students and parent/drivers receive a safety briefing, materials, and instructions.

8:30 AM Teams assemble with their parent/drivers and depart for their sectors.

9:00 AM Solicitation begins.

11:00 AM Teams return for additional routes, if needed.

12:00 - 1:00 PM Solicitation ends.

1:30 PM Teams return to the school to turn-in forms and money.
