Please remember that chaperones may not administer any medicines without your permission. The Choir carries the common over-the-counter medicines, *or their generic/other equivalent*, listed below. If a medicine is not on the list, you must provide it and list it on the "other needed medication" section of this form.

ONLY emergency prescription medications may be carried by a student on this trip. (e.g. inhalers and epipens.) All other medicines will be kept with a designated chaperone for the duration of the trip.
